HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATOR

- Under general supervision, to operate heavy power-driven construction and maintenance equipment.
 - Participate in the work of water distribution and drainage facilities and maintenance and construction crews and to do related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES

(Included but not limited to)

The ability to operate heavy power-driven construction maintenance equipment & track- driven equipment that may include:

- Rubber tired loaders
 - Loaders
 - Excavators
 - Backhoes
 - Dump Trucks
 - Tractors
 - Motor Graders
 - Scrapers
 - Water Trucks
 - Dozers
- Inspect, clean, and perform minor servicing of equipment.
- Report the need for major mechanical repairs to appropriate district staff.
- Read maps, plans, diagrams, drawings, and grade stakes when performing cuts and fills.
- Perform maintenance and construction work, operating a variety of hand and power tools when necessary.
- Assist in the installation of pipes, pipe structures, gates, and cement work.
- Locate and repair leaks.
- Perform emergency repair assignments as needed.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must be able to carry, push, pull, reach, lift equipment and parts weighing up to 50 lbs.
- Must be able to stoop, kneel, crouch, crawl and climb during field maintenance and repair work.
 - Work in an outside environment with exposure to **dust**, **dirt**, and significant temperature changes between **cold** and **extreme heat**.
 - Stand and walk for extended periods of time.
 - Operate assigned heavy equipment with skill and safety.
 - Perform heavy physical labor requiring strength, dexterity, and agility.
- Must have sufficient hand-eye coordination, hearing, vision, and motor skills.

SPECIAL REQUIRMENTS

- **Must** possess a **Class A** license or an equivalent operator's license issued by the State Department of Motor Vehicles.
- Must provide proof of driving record of the past two (2) years free of infractions.
 - Will be subjected to random drug screenings.
 - Must be knowledgeable of <u>Motor Vehicle Laws and Regulations</u> and <u>Proper Safety Standards</u> regarding <u>Heavy Equipment Operation</u>.

DESIRABLE EXPERIECE

- Two (2) years of responsible experience in the operation of heavy rubbertired and track-driven equipment.
 - General maintenance and construction work.
 - Work without immediate supervision at job sites.
